



Professor Ouele was born in Bangoua (West Cameroon, Africa). Until the age of nine months, he could walk and run, but at 12 months old, polio paralyzed him. Due to the lack of resources and facilities, he was then condemned to crawl for many years.

Despite his infirmity, he attended school and gained education, including the Universities of Yaounde, Douala, Buea, Strayer University, and Walden University. He became a teacher and taught standard classes on the high school level for twelve years before turning his focus to the education of students with special needs.

Professor Ouele received his Ph.D. in education from Walden University.

He has structured several programs for the training and placement of disabled persons' associations including the "Arc-en-ciel" and the Sports and Leisure Association for the Disabled (Association Sports et Loisirs pour Handicapés, ASLOH).

He is a writer and a researcher in psychology for the disabled; with a mission that's being dedicated to enabling disabled persons through Inspirational and Motivational speaking.

To boost the reach of his messages, Professor Ouele uses his gifts and talents as a singer/songwriter to open up the hearts and minds of the world to injustices and to perpetuate messages of peace. He organizes community service events to provide food and resources for those residents who are in need.
